

CRIME ALERT Attempted Rape/Sexual Battery on August 20, 2017

On August 20, 2017 at 4:00am, a woman, who is not a KU student, reported she was walking in the 1700 block of Naismith Drive (Lot 90). She was grabbed by an unknown male and pinned to the ground. She fought the suspect, who got up and ran from the area.

The description of the suspect is:

- White male
- Wavy brown hair, over the ear in length and beard
- Dark shirt, Khaki pants
- Tattoo on left arm
