

# KU Crime Alert

## Robbery

### Summary:

**On June 13, 2009, at approximately 1:50 a.m. the victim was approached by two black males outside of Sprague Apartments, 1400 Alumni Place. The victim was struck in the face and put in a headlock. After the suspects took the victim's money, they left walking east towards 14<sup>th</sup> and Ohio. The suspects match the description of two other robberies in the area south of 14<sup>th</sup> and Ohio that the Lawrence Police Department is investigating. (The suspects' composites and descriptions are on the attached page.)**
